Water Event

Interest groups donate money to build water treatment plants in many industrializing countries. The plants significantly lower the amount of pollution released into the water supply.



Composite material technology advances. New jet engines are lighter and more fuel-efficient, reducing the amount of fuel needed by the air transportation industry.



**Special Event** 

Construction technology advances. New housing developments use living vegetation combined with solar panel technology to create efficient rooftops that generate electricity from the sun. You may swap one of your saved species with that of another player.



Water Event

The water requirements of the selected species are now closed. If this is the last set of requirements remaining on the species the species is saved. This card cannot be interrupted.



Choose a target action event (red) to block, Normal Block blocks the effect of the targeted card. Normal Block counts as an action event.



Discard

Choose a player other than yourself. That player must discard two cards, randomly chosen by you, to your hand. Discard down to the hand limit if necessary.



**Land Event** 

A new international law passes. The law protects the world's current forestation percentage making destruction of any forests illegal.
